School Compliance for Veterans Benefits

MSP will not impose any penalty, including the assessment of late fees, the denial of access to classes, the library, or other facilities, or require students to borrow additional funds, on any covered individual because of the individual's inability to meet his or her financial obligations to MSP due to delayed disbursement funding from the VA under chapter 31 or 33.
