The Marjorie Scott Scholarship for Excellence was established in January 2006 to honor Dr. Scott, Faculty Emerita and former Program Director, for her commitment to academic excellence. This scholarship is presented at commencement to a graduating student from each program who has best achieved excellence in academics, clinical work, and research.

Eligibility criteria:

- Successful fulfillment of all degree requirements.
- Outstanding academic achievement throughout the program.
- Active participation in the MSP community.
- Demonstrated excellence in academic performance, presentations, clinical training, scholarly projects, publications, and professional behavior.
- PsyD graduates – demonstrated excellence in dissertation.
