The Student Emergency Loan Fund (SELF) provides immediate aid to students with an emergency financial situation who have exhausted other available financial resources. This is a loan, and is to be repaid within 4 months. To be eligible, students must be in good academic standing per the MSP registrar, be enrolled at least half-time, and must provide documentation of the financial emergency.
