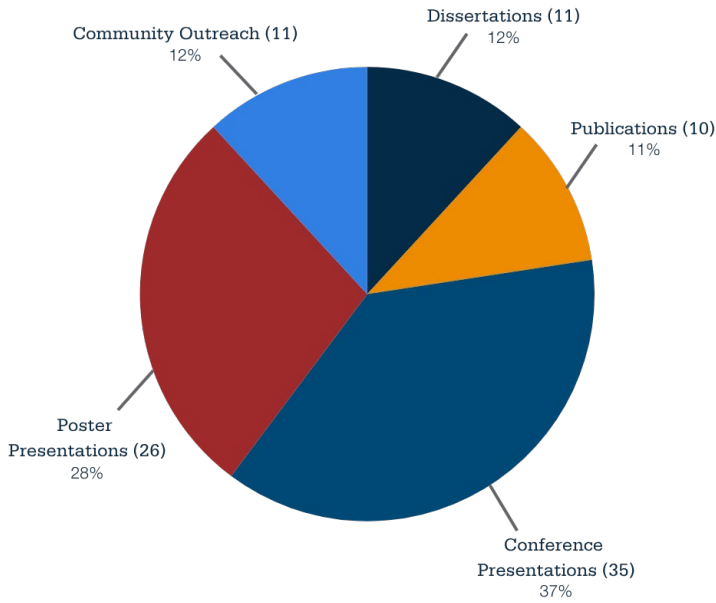

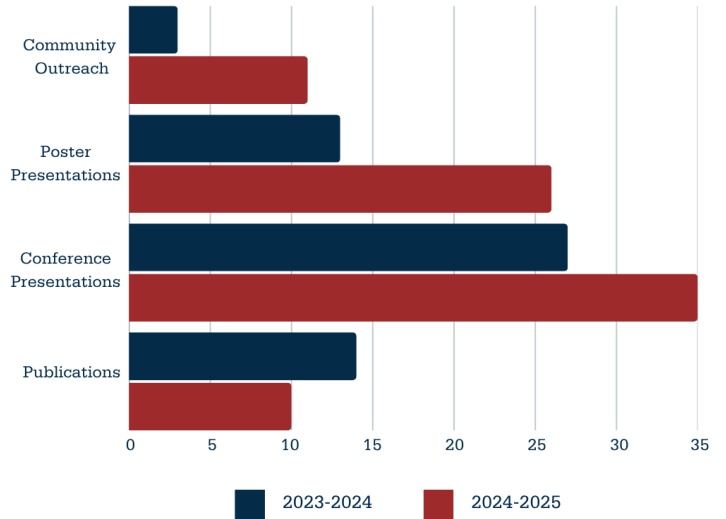

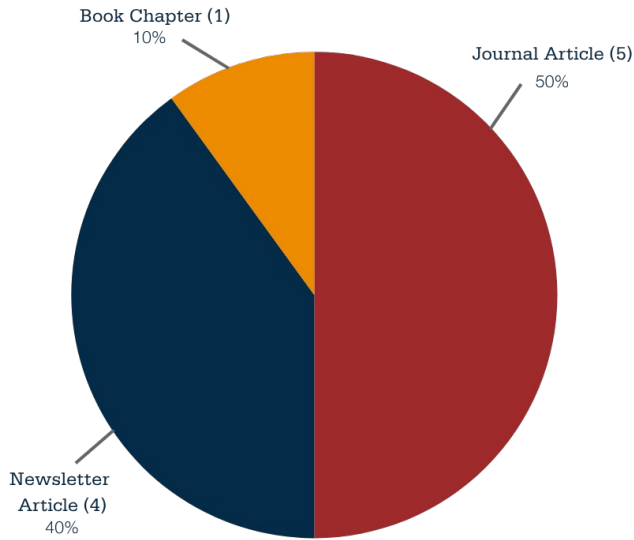
Types of Scholarly Activities



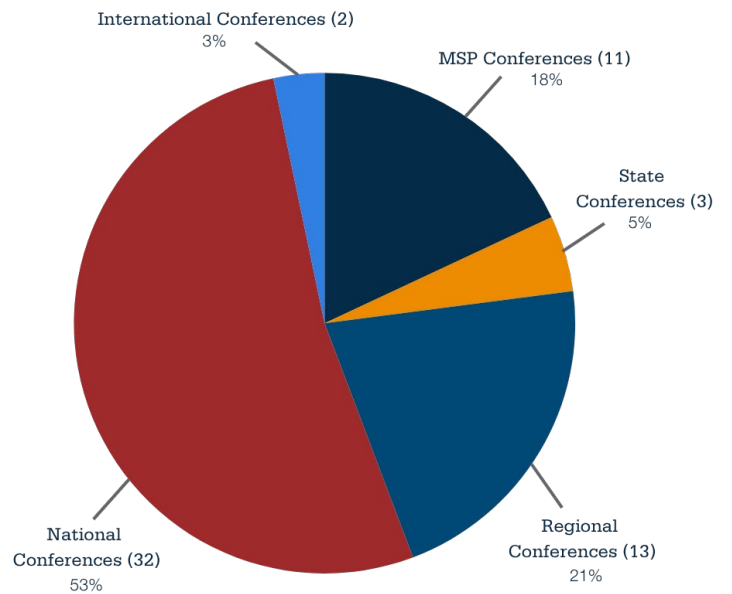
2024-2025 Scholarly Output Compared to 2023-2024



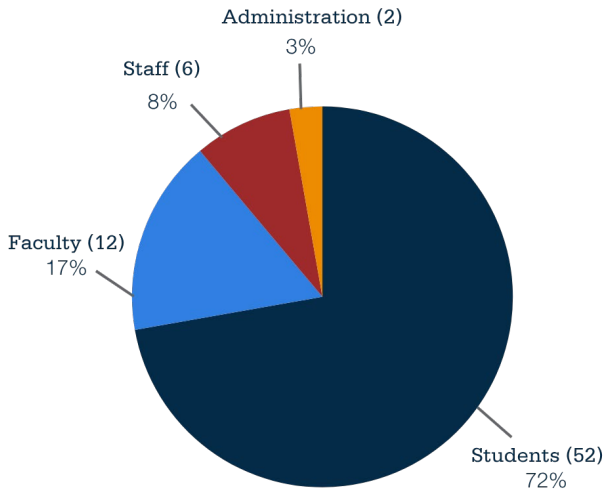
Publication Types 2024-2025 Academic Year



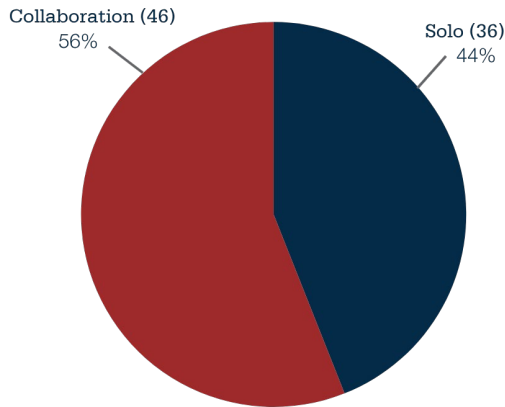
Conference Level



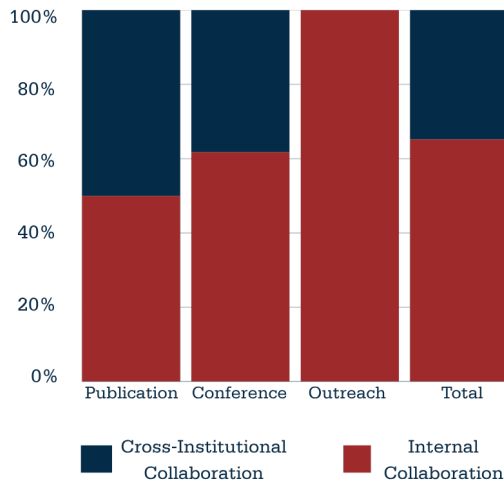
MSP Researcher Roles

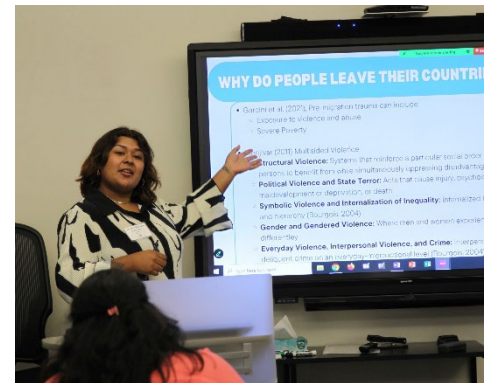

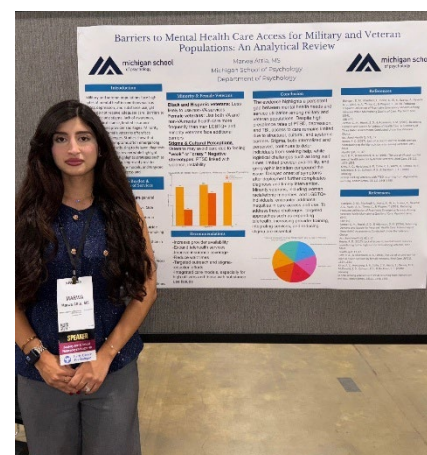
